# ANNUAL REPORT 2023 - '24

St. Ann's Public School, Eloor, Udyogamandal is one of the prestigious schools of the Sacred Heart Province of Adoration Congregation. The school was started in accordance with the Vision of our founder, Venerable Mar Thomas Kurialassery. We aim for the holistic development of our students and take special care to instil spiritual and moral values in them, along with academic excellence.

#### **INTRODUCTION**

Every academic year is a significant milestone in the history of all educational institutions, which is also very special to our school, St. Ann's Public School, Eloor. We are successfully stepping ahead towards the end of the 19th academic year, in providing quality education.

Looking back at the 2023 – '24 academic year, it can be said with all conviction that we have a great deal to be proud of and grateful for as a school community. Students continued to excel scholastically and non-scholastically in a very student–centred learning environment. This is the result of our supportive management, outstanding faculty and staff members, as well as a positive partnership that has been developed between our parents and school. Our success as a school is the endeavour to fulfil the motto of 'Love and Service' with the vision of forming God-fearing, competent, confident, effective and efficient youth with high spiritual and moral values, to become responsible citizens of the nation. St. Ann's Public School, in its pursuit of holistic education, envisages inspiring and fostering a community of caring, progressive and empowered learners, striving to be global citizens, in an atmosphere of mutual respect, understanding and trust.

It is with gratitude and extreme honour that I present the 19th Annual Report of St. Ann's Public School, Eloor. This report gives a glimpse of the activities and achievements both in the curricular and co-curricular arenas during the academic year 2023-2024.

#### ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

To achieve academic excellence, it is essential to create an environment that fosters the development of a community that can grow intellectually, socially and ethically, and is,

therefore, able to pursue successful and fulfilling careers. The excellent result of SSE and SSCE of this academic year is a reflection of the school's successful efforts.

Excellence in education is the hallmark of St Ann's Public School, Eloor. We are proud to place before you the achievement of our students and the progress of our school. The school secured 100% results in both SSC and SSCE examinations. Out of 80 students from class 10, 2 students- Swetha K B (scored 482/500) and Abhay Krishna P A (Scored 475/500) secured A1 in all subjects, 70 students secured Distinction and 10 students secured First class in 2022-23 SSE Examinations. School toppers from class 10 are Swetha K B and Abhay Krishna P A.

In SSCE, from the Science stream- out of 39 students, 3 students, Adila Farsana V N (scored 472/500), Afsal V N (scored 470/500) and Aparna M (scored 467/500) secured A1 in all subjects, 33 students secured distinction and 22 students secured first class. School toppers from the Science stream are Adila Farsana V N, Afsal V N and Aparna M.

From Commerce stream: out of 16 students, 6 secured Distinction and 10 secured First class. Commerce stream toppers are Aletta Joseph (Scored 431/500) and Deol T.F (scored 431/500).

I congratulate the students, parents and teachers for their hard work, perseverance, and determination leading to higher results.

### **ISO CERTIFICATION**

ISO inspection in the school was held on 7th November 2023. We are happy to announce that our school is being upgraded to ISO 9001-2015 by the United Accreditation Forum of USA Member IAF.

### ADMISSION

Individuals having diverse backgrounds, values, traditions, and cultures enter our portal of learning. Due to the availability of limited seats, a fair and transparent process is adopted to admit students in different classes. We have the strength of 1175 students from Pre KG to Std XII, providing more personal support and greater access to opportunities in their chosen fields of interest.

### STAFF

We are fortunate to have a talented, highly committed teaching and supporting staff to ensure a positive learning environment for the students. Our school has a strong team of 72 staff members in all capacities, which includes 55 teaching faculty members, 7 administrative staff, and 11 non-teaching staff, who are a well-knit, well-qualified, serious, and purposeful group of people.

### SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE

The Infrastructure at the school contributes to the positive learning environment. Every classroom has audio-visual facilities including live streaming of classroom teaching, a public address system, a display board and age-appropriate furniture.

Library, Multi-purpose rooms, IT and Science Laboratories and Play Ground which help to build motor skills in children. This well-planned framework of our school provides creative learning and critical thinking capabilities in children.

We are equipped with barrier-free facilities, wheelchair access, comfortable classrooms and other safety aspects like elevators. (The work is in progress).

### **RE-OPENING**

After the refreshing Summer break, St. Ann's Public School, Eloor reopened on 1st June 2023. The campus accorded a rousing reception to the existing students and the newcomers who stepped into the haver of the School to unravel the green joyous moments of learning. The entire St. Ann's family extended its warmth with drum beats offering a perfect ambience of welcome, followed by a reopening programme presided over by Principal Dr Sr Lizy P.J.

• Fresher's Day: To welcome the students of class XI, Freshers Day was organised by our class XII students. The gathering included messages from the Principal and higher secondary teachers. Various cultural events and activities were organised.

### TRAINING, SEMINARS AND ORIENTATION PROGRAMMES

Every academic year training, seminars and Orientation programmes are conducted for teachers and students to improve and implement innovative ideas in teaching-learning practices and to ignite the students beyond their current level of learning.

### **TEACHERS' TRAINING**

 A Three-day orientation programme from 8th to 10th May 2023 was conducted for teachers on the topic "Effective classroom communication", followed by various activities encouraging collaboration among teachers, and fostering a culture of Continuous improvement. Faculty members from ACT INTERNATIONAL, English Accent and Creative Teaching, under the leadership of Mr Edwin and team, led the Sessions.

• One-day Capacity building programme for teachers was conducted at Mary Matha School, Thrikkakara by the management on 11th May 2023.

Apart from the training provided by the school, each teacher has undergone a considerable number of trainings of around 50 hours both online and offline, organised by CBSE, various publishing and other centres.

• **Parents' Orientations:** Parent orientation sessions provide an opportunity for educators to build trust and rapport with parents. Parent orientation classes were organised on 10th June 2023. The first Session was for classes 1-5 led by Rev Fr. Thomas Pereppadan on the topic "Effective Parenting".

The second session was for parents of classes 6-12 led by Rev. Fr. Aji on the topic "Parenting in Modern Era".

### VALUE EDUCATION

Our school is determined to produce well-groomed citizens of high moral values who can lead society and nations. Therefore, imparting moral and spiritual lessons in all classes, successfully executed by our moral science teachers right from class I to XII along with periodical exams.

### SCHOOL COUNSELLING

Realising the need for all-round development of our students. School is providing a Counselling Corner, administered by Dr Sr Mercelit Kunnathukalam, where students of different classes are given timely counselling and moral instructions.

The efforts of the school counsellor have tremendously supported the students in their overall development. Counselling service is extended to the parents/teachers too when needed. The needs of the students are taken into account with the support of the school counsellor, who guides them in the areas of academic achievements, personal/social and career development, ensuring today's students become productive, well–adjusted adults of tomorrow.

We are also getting counselling assistance from Mrs Thara Anitha Mathew, who is pursuing her Post Graduate Diploma in Clinical Social Work at Rajagiri College of Social Sciences. As a trainee she helps us, to lead our younger minds free from anxieties of modern lifestyle.

#### THE STUDENT COUNCIL

The student council is a body of elected members. In order to inculcate the values of leadership quality and to develop the spirit of democracy among students, we have created a student council. It plays an important role by being a mediator between the students and the school management. It comprises office bearers, discipline in charge and class representatives.

Student Council including School Head Boy, Head Girl, House Captains, Vice Captains and other Council members under the guidance of House in charge teachers help in conducting various school events and programmes.

#### **INVESTITURE CEREMONY**

The Investiture Ceremony for the academic session 2023-24 was held with great vigour and dignity. The ceremony commenced with the lighting of a ceremonial lamp. The elected Head girl Kumari. Sreelekshmi Manoj and School Head Boy Master. Abhay Krishna P A introduced themselves and they were conferred with badges and sashes by the chief guest Shri. Balan K, Inspector, SHO, Eloor in the presence of Principal, house in charge teachers, elected house leaders and cabinet members. # **CLUB ACTIVITIES**

### • Science and Eco Club.
